


Fellows Application Process - Guidance Notes for Applicants

CV of Biography of your career history	This should be:
	-up to date
	-chronologically complete with no unexplained gaps
Case study template (2 required)	Complete the case study form for each case study you wish
	to present in support of your application covering a succinct
	summary of the assignment including:
	- relevant background on the business (for example size and
	type of business, national / international reach, complexity
	and type of stakeholders).
	- the key challenges the business faced
	- your role in leading the turnaround and key achievements
	- the challenges you faced in delivering the turnaround
	- any feedback you received on the assignment
	The case study template should be no more than 2 sides to
	provide enough background to enable the committee to
	develop a deeper understanding of the assignment during
	the interview.
Case study referees	-please select one referee for each case study
	- the referee should be someone with whom you worked
	closely in delivering the assignment and would typically be
	board level or equivalent
	-references will be sought following your interview
	-we recommend you seek referees approval before
	submission
