

The Fellows Code

The Fellows Code is a set of guiding principles Fellows can refer to to inform how they choose to support the development of The IFT and its members. The code also helps ensure some parameter to deliver alignment of effort across the Fellows in their support of The IFT and members. The following areas represent opportunities for Fellows to make a broader contribution to The IFT:

Supporting Development of The IFT and profiling the Fellows at The IFT Events:

- Attending specific Fellows events/dinners.
- Attending the Annual Conference.
- Attending the AGM.
- Attending the Annual Awards Dinner.
- · Attending Regional Meetings.
- Participating in one or more of the Specialist Groups/undertake projects on behalf of the Board.

Supporting the development of members by being available:

- For pre-application meetings with prospective new Members/supporting
- To participate in Members mentoring scheme and/or informally mentor Members who request assistance with membership
- To participate in CPD Events and profile Fellows case studies on approach to assignments.
- To participate in, or attend, Academy sessions.

There are no de-minimus criteria around the quantity or nature of the broader contribution a Fellow makes to The IFT. Individual circumstances and opportunities will differ; substance over form is the guiding principle. The guidelines above are not exhaustive but do provide helpful consistency.
